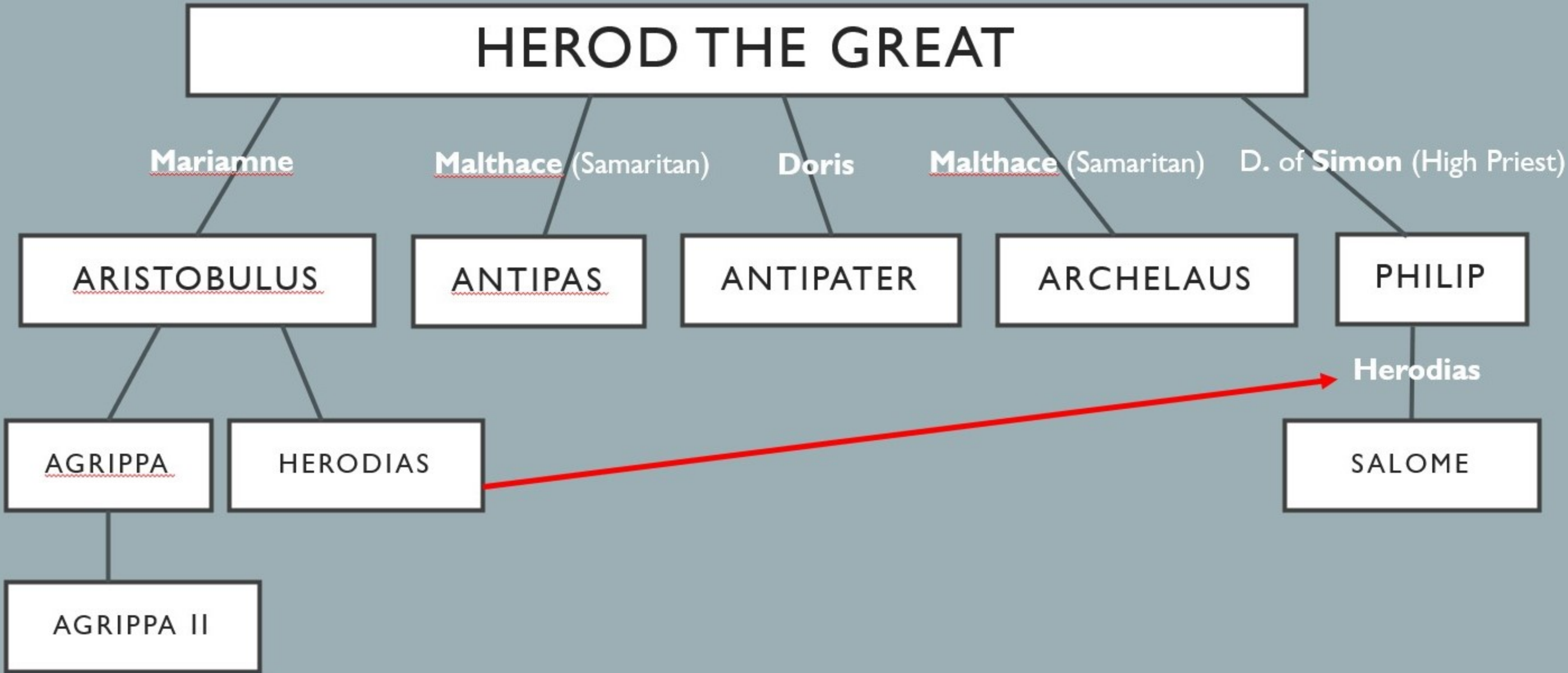

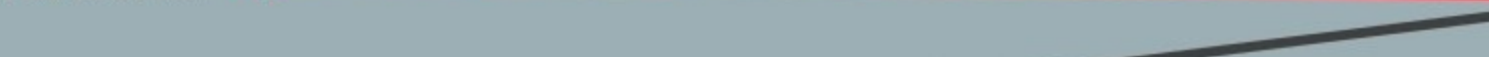

AGRIPPA II

- **Herod the Great:** Birth of Christ; Murder of the Innocents (Matthew 2)
- **Archelaus:** Joseph, Mary & Jesus return from Egypt (Matthew 2:22)
- **Antipas:** “Herod the Tetrarch” (Ruler of a quarter) Reigned during life of Christ. Beheaded John the Baptist. Accused of treason by Agrippa. Then exiled, along with Herodias, to Gaul.
- **Agrippa:** With death of Philip and exile of Antipas, he is granted authority over all of Herod’s Kingdom by Emperor Claudius. Killed James and imprisoned Peter. (Acts 12)
- **Agrippa II:** Hears the Apostle Paul’s defense along with his wife (and sister), Bernice. (Acts 25-26)
